- **Register to vote and vote on the same day** between October 16<sup>th</sup> and November 1<sup>st</sup> at Early Voting locations in Mecklenburg County. Call 888-OUR-VOTE or visit [www.2008ElectionConnection](http://www.2008ElectionConnection) for more information on Same Day Registration & Voting.

**All citizens 18 years of age or older on November 4<sup>th</sup> who have been residents of Mecklenburg County for at least 30 days are eligible to register and vote locally.**
